

L.11 AGAR 452.237-71 PRE-BID/PRE-PROPOSAL CONFERENCE (FEB 1988)

(a) The Government is planning a pre-bid/pre-proposal conference, during which potential offerors may obtain a better understanding of the work required.

(b) **Offerors are required to submit all questions in writing at least five (5) days prior to the conference.** Questions will be considered at any time prior to or during the conference however offerors will be required to confirm verbal questions in writing.
