## East Foothill Trail #192

Distance: This trail is 7 miles long.

Difficulty: Moderate

USGS Quad: Condon, Holland Peak, and Holland Lake

Beginning Elevation: 4,520 ft


Ending Elevation: 4,480 ft

Directions: From Holland Lake: From Highway 83 turn east onto Holland Lake Road #44 near mile marker 35. Follow this road about 4 miles to its end, past the day use site and campground, to access the trailhead. Trail #192 starts at the junction with 415, approximately 1.1 miles from the trailhead.  
From East Foothill: From Highway 83 turn east onto Rumble Creek Rd also called Forest Service Road #560 near mile marker 40. Continue 3.7 miles to the end of this road for the trailhead.

Season: This trail is normally free of snow by mid-May.

Regulations: Hiking, horse riding and mountain biking are allowed on these trails. Motorized vehicles, including motorcycles, are prohibited.


Trail Description: This trail meanders along the base of the Swan Range near Holland Peak. This trail climbs and descends, but the overall elevation change is low. This trail can be accessed from the East Foothill trailhead near Cooney Lookout, or from Holland Lake. To reach this trail from Holland Lake, first take trail #415 for 1.1 miles to the junction with the East Foothill Trail.
