OCCUPANCY AND USE

**PROHIBITIONS:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System Lands described in this order, all within the Salmon-Challis National Forest, **outside the boundaries of the Frank Church River Of No Return Wilderness** until further notice.

1. Camping or otherwise occupying the same location or any site within a Five (5) mile radius of the same location for a period longer than Sixteen (16) consecutive days. **36 CFR 261.58(a).**
2. After camping or occupying the same location for Sixteen (16) consecutive days, returning to that location or any site within a Five (5) mile radius of that location within less than Thirty (30) days. **36 CFR 261.58(a).**

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

**AREA DESCRIBED:**

All National Forest System Lands, outside the boundaries of the Frank Church River Of No Return Wilderness, including developed recreation sites and undeveloped areas located within or administered by the Salmon-Challis National Forest all within Idaho.

**PURPOSE:**

This limit of stay restriction is necessary to reduce displacement of other Forest visitors desiring to utilize a particular area, by reducing the opportunity for one visitor or group of visitors from monopolizing a campsite for long periods of time (in excess of 16 days). It also reduces the environmental impacts associated with long term established camps, and to help reduce the incidents related to unauthorized residential camping.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
3. This Order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in the above-described area.
