Thank you for your interest in providing visitor services at various recreation sites within the Fremont-Winema National Forest. The prospectus (solicitation for offers) is now available for review and downloading on the Forest Service website (address below). Detailed information on this business opportunity, Forest Service concession program and policies, special use permit, application and post-selection requirements are available in the prospectus. This website will also serve as the main source of information and updates throughout this solicitation and selection process.

Prospective applicants will be provided the opportunity to participate in a site visit to view the recreation sites included in the prospectus. The site visit will be scheduled in July (2011). Applications submitted in response to this prospectus are subject to cost recovery pursuant to 36 CFR 251.58(c)(3)(iii). Applicants must submit an application fee of \$500 to cover the cost of the prospectus and review of the application. The selected applicant will be responsible for the cost of preparing and issuing the permit and conducting a Financial Ability Determination (FAD), unless the Forest Service has conducted a FAD on the applicant within the past year. Payments due to the United States for this application must be paid in the form of a bank draft, money order, or cashier's check **payable to the USDA—Forest Service**.

Complete applications (with fee payable to the USDA—Forest Service) must be submitted to Margaret David Bailey, District Ranger, attention: Mike DeSmit, 2819 Dahlia ST, Klamath Falls, OR 97601. Applications must be received by close of business (4:30 p.m.) on August 8, 2011.
