### **Applicable Forest Orders**

Order No. 20-01-92-001

ORDER

VEHICLE USE CLOSURE  
Winema National Forest

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the area on the Winema National Forest described in this order from January 1 through August 31 of each year until rescinded:

1. Using any type of motorized vehicle (to include ATV's, motorboats, and snowmobiles) except on those roads and trails identified as open for motorized use.  
36 CFR 261.54 (a)
2. Possessing or using any motorized vehicle off forest development roads or trails.  
36 CFR 261.56

Pursuant to title 36 CFR Section 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Area Description - Klamath Bald Eagle Habitat Management Area

1. Beginning at the junction of Forest Road 3455 (old Pelican Butte Road) and County Road 531 (Westside Road), all National Forest system land north of Forest Road 3455 and west of the Westside Road, north to Forest Road 3419 (Rock Creek Road), as identified on the attached map.
2. All National Forest system land east of County Road 531 (Westside Road) located in T.35S, R.6E, Sections 11, 14, 23, 26, and 35; and T.36S, R.6E SE 1/4 Sec. 3, SW 1/4 Sec. 3, SE 1/4 Sec. 4, and the NE 1/4 Sec. 9, as identified on the attached map.

ORDER  
USE OF VEHICLES ON FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS  
ROGUE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST  
WINEMA NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations Section 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited on the roads listed in Appendices A, B and C within the Rogue River and Winema National Forests until further notice.

- (1) Using any vehicle except those designed for over-the-snow travel that are less than 54 inches gross width on the Forest development roads listed in Appendices A, B and C when the road or segment is snow covered (snow depths greater than 6 inches). This will be in effect from November 15 through March 30 ANNUALLY, unless local snow conditions require a change. Title 36 CFR 261.54(a)

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local Officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (3) Persons authorized to operate Oregon State Snowmobile Association snowgrooming equipment.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR 261 sub-part "A".

This Order supersedes the Order signed June 23, 1983, for the Winema National Forest.

ORDER

Forest Development Roads  
Winema National Forest

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), Maximum Allowable Speed Restrictions for all motorized vehicles are imposed on the Forest development roads, listed in this order, in and around the Lake of the Woods area, Winema National Forest. This order is effective May 1, 1995, and will remain in effect until rescinded.

1. Forest Service Road 3601 from Oregon Highway 140 to Dead Indian Memorial Highway. Maximum speed shall be thirty (30) miles per hour unless otherwise posted. (36 CFR 261.54(d))

2. Forest Service Road 3732, the entire length. Maximum speed shall be fifteen (15) miles per hour unless otherwise posted. (36 CFR 261.54(d))

Warning - This order may be radar enforced.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, state, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

**ORDER**  
**FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS**  
**FREMONT-WINEMA NATIONAL FORESTS**

**Order Number 2003-00-01**

Pursuant to 36 Code of Federal Regulations Part 261.50 (b) the following act(s) are prohibited on any National Forest System Roads managed by the Fremont-Winema National Forests.

A National Forest System Road is defined as: *Any road wholly, or partly within or adjacent to and serving as a part of the National Forest System, and which has been included in the Forest Development Road System Plan.*

The prohibitions in this order are intended to promote safety for employees and forest users while on public roads administrated by the Fremont-Winema National Forests.

**This order becomes effective at 0001 hours on May 24th, 2003 and will remain in effect until rescinded.**

**PROHIBITION**

- (1) Operating or driving any motorized vehicle without a valid operators license, issued by any recognized governmental entity when an operators license is required by State law.      **ORS 807.010      36 CFR 261.54(d)**
  
- (2) Operating or driving any motorized vehicle with an expired, suspended or revoked operators license when an operators license is required.      **ORS 811.182      36 CFR 261.54(d)**
  
- (3) Operating or driving any motorized vehicle that is not insured as required by Oregon State laws, when insurance is required.      **ORS 806.010      36 CFR 261.54(d)**
  
- (4) Operating or driving any motorized vehicle without all persons using provided safety restraints when safety restraints are provided by the manufacturer.      **ORS 811.210      36 CFR 261.54(d)**
  
- (5) Operating or driving any motorized vehicle when the driver is impaired by alcohol, controlled substance or other substance or condition that impairs the ability to drive safely.      **ORS 813.010      36 CFR 261.54(d)**

(6) Operating or driving any motorized vehicle when an open container of alcohol, as defined by State law, is present in the driver/passenger compartment.

ORS 811.170      36 CFR 261.54(d)

(7) Operating or driving any motorized vehicle with impaired or defective safety equipment. This includes brakes, lights, horn, safety glass and exhaust system when so equipped by the manufacturer.

ORS 816.330      36 CFR 261.54(d)

(8) Operating or driving any motorized vehicle in violation of posted speed limits.

ORS 811.110      36 CFR 261.54(d)

(9) Failure to obey any traffic control device or regularity sign.

ORS 811.265      36 CFR 261.54(d)

(10) Operating or driving a motorized vehicle that is not legally licensed or registered by a recognized country, state or governmental agency.

ORS 803.330      36 CFR 261.54(d)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from prohibitions # 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 8, 9, and 10, contained within this order.

(1) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
