

OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTIONS

Roosevelt National Forest

Long Draw Forest Road #156

Pursuant to Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations 261.50(b) the following acts are prohibited on Forest Road 156, the Long Draw road, on the Roosevelt National Forest in Larimer County, Colorado. The restricted road is depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A. The purpose of this order is to provide for public safety while dead trees and other hazards are removed.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Using any type of motorized vehicle. 36 CFR 261.54(a)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This order is in effect from July 1, 2011 through July 30, 2011 or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.
