ACCESSIBLE AREAS FOR PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED: ♿

Oaks Picnic Area: Day Use only.

West Fork Road: Access for the disabled is available by permit at the San Gabriel River Ranger District located in Glendora. Glenn Camp has three sites available for disabled.

ROADS:

Highway 39: Open to Crystal Lake Road junction (mm 38.13).

East Fork Road: Open

Mt. Baldy Road: Open.

Glendora Ridge Road: Open

Glendora Mtn Road: Open

Crystal Lake Road: Open

OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE AREAS & ROUTES:

Registration and Forest Service approved spark arrestors are required. ATV and dirt bike riders must wear a helmet. ATV riders under age of 18 must complete a safety course. All vehicles must meet local, State and Federal laws.

No Alcoholic beverages are allowed.

Areas may be closed at any time due to unsafe conditions caused by storms, fire danger or excessive use capacity.

San Gabriel Canyon OHV Area: Saturday/Sunday 8 am to 4:00 pm. All vehicles must exit the area by 5:00 pm.

FEES: \$8.00 for the Primary vehicle and \$5.00 for each additional vehicle.

Rincon-Shortcut OHV Route: Open for hike-in and mountain bicycles. **Closed to motor vehicles due to road conditions. Permit not required.**

SAN GABRIEL RIVER RANGER DISTRICT (SGRRD) continued:

CAMPGROUNDS: Propane and pressurized gas stoves allowed. Must have immediate source of water/soil at all sites.

Manker Flats Campground: Open. First-come/First-serve. **\$14.00** per site/per night for one car and \$5.00 for second vehicle. 21 sites available. RV length varies between 16-22 feet. Running water and flush toilets are available. Open fire in the fire pit provided. (Bring your own wood). Charcoal in the grill provided.

Glenn Trail Camp: Open. First-come/first-serve. Ten sites available. Three sites are handicap accessible. Access is hike-in or bicycles. Vehicle access with permit for disabled. Pit toilets and stream water available. Fire in the fire ring and charcoal in the grill provided by the Forest Service. **Campfire permit is required.**

Coldbrook Campground: Open. No drinkable water. First Come/First Serve. \$12.00 per site for one vehicle and \$5.00 for second vehicle. Pit toilets. Stream water available...must be treated before drinking. Fire in the fire ring provided. Propane and pressurized gas stoves allowed.

Crystal Lake Campground: Open 7 days. Gate access is 6:00 am to 6:00 pm. A Daily Adventure Pass is required and may be purchased at the Visitor Center (Saturday & Sunday) and Crystal Lake Store (closed Monday). The Annual AP, Interagency-America the Beautiful and Golden Passport will be accepted.

Day Use is limited to the Picnic Area and Overnight camping is limited to 36 sites in Loops A & B. First-Come/First Serve. Charcoal in the grill and fire in ring provided by the FS (bring your own firewood).

Crystal Lake is open for fishing. **NO** swimming. Hike in 1 mile from Information Station.

RIVERS and STREAMS: San Gabriel River and San Antonio River are running a little high and slightly fast. Be aware when crossing.

FISHING:

A valid California fishing license is required. For **stocking information**, contact the California State Fish and Game Department at (562) 594-7268.

West Fork: Only **artificial** flies or lures with a **single barbless hook** may be used in the West Fork and its tributaries. From the second crossing up it is "**Catch and Release**" only.

East Fork: Open

North Fork: Open.

San Gabriel Dam: North shoreline only.

San Antonio River: Open

Crystal Lake: Open. No swimming.

SAN GABRIEL RIVER RANGER DISTRICT (SGRRD) continued:

TARGET SHOOTING:

Burro Canyon Shooting Park: Thursday through Monday, from 9 am to 4 pm. For further information call (626) 910-1344.

PICNIC AREAS:

The Oaks: 14 group picnic sites for **Day-Use Only**. Restrooms are available. Charcoal allowed in the grills provided. **No wood fires**. Self-contained Bar-B-Q's, propane and pressurized gas camp stoves are allowed. An Adventure Pass or Interagency Passport is required.

HIKING TRAILS:

GENERAL INFORMATION: For safety reasons, hiking trails are **not** recommended for equestrian or bicycle travel.

Mt. Baldy trails and peak: Open.

Icehouse Canyon: Open

Bridge to Nowhere: Open. One river crossing is 2 to 2 ½ feet deep and water is running fast.

West Fork and Bear Creek trail:

Upper Bear Creek Trail (off Hwy 39) is open to creek (5.5 miles one-way).

Lower Bear Creek Trail (off the West Fork) is open for the first 3 miles.
