SPECIAL CLOSURE

PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF 16 U.S.C., SECTION 551 AND 36 C.F.R. 261.50 (a) AND (b), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT THE FOLLOWING ACTS ARE PROHIBITED ON THE AREA DESCRIBED IN THIS ORDER AS, **WALLACE MINE (MINING CONTRACT AREA OOC-34, NESW SE SECTION 19, T3S, R24W)** WITHIN THE OUACHITA NATIONAL FOREST.

FOR THE PROTECTION OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY THE FOLLOWING ACTS ARE PROHIBITED AND ARE SET FORTH IN 36 CFR 261.53:

Going into or being upon the area. 261.53 (e)

PURSUANT TO 36 CFR, SECTION 261.50 (e), THE FOLLOWING PERSONS ARE EXEMPT FROM THIS ORDER:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions 36 CFR part 261, Subpart A.

THIS ORDER WILL EXPIRE FIVE (5) YEARS FROM DATE OF EXECUTION
