

Sly Creek Dam Road Closure

Forest Service Road 21N16 across the Sly Creek Dam will be closed starting Monday July 11, 2011 and will remain in effect until mid-October. The Sly Creek campground and boat launch will remain open. The road closure is located about 1 mile northwest of La Porte Road, in legal location T20N, R7E, Section 19 (northeast corner). On July 11, Teichert will close the gate on the south side of the bridge and begin installing temporary fencing. Removal of the bridge should follow shortly thereafter. There will be a final garbage service and sewage pumping service at Sly Creek campground and boat launch, and then South Feather Water and Power Agency personnel will haul out garbage as needed.

An alternate route to access Sly Creek campground and boat launch has been provided:

Off of La Porte Road, turn left on to Barton Hill Road, and then left on to County Road 111. Turn right on to Forest Road 20N09, stay to the left and continue straight across the Lost Creek Dam bridge (will carry truck, trailer, and boat). Follow north up the left side of Pinkard Creek then left on to Forest Road 20N57. Turn right on to Forest Road 20N24, and continue until the Sly Creek Reservoir, then right on to the northern section of Forest Road 21N16 and the Sly Creek campground.

Strawberry campground and car-top boat launch will remain open and accessible. After July 15, 2011, Golden Trout Crossing will open up, Forest Road 20N24 will be completely open and Sly Creek will be accessed by that route as well.

The road across the Sly Creek Dam closure will be effective July 11, 2011 until about mid-October 2011. For more information contact Herman Wendell at Feather River Ranger District, (530) 532-7466.
