

## JUNIOR RANGER PROGRAMS

These are 45 to 60 minute programs for kids ages 5 – 11. Learn about lots of things like fire in the forest or mountain building or about animal habitats!

## DISCOVERY STATIONS

No time commitment here! Come and go from these quick stations which are located in a variety of places around Redfish Lake. Maybe you can find us at the Redfish Lodge, maybe at the Fishhook Creek Bridge, maybe even at your campsite! These stations might be about scat and tracks or macroinvertebrates or a variety of other topics!

## NATURE WALKS

These Nature Walks aren't focused on the destination, but the journey! Learn about the nature you observe from our interpretive specialists. These walks are 60 to 75 minutes long. Meet at the Redfish Center before traveling to the trailhead.

## SAWTOOTH SYNOPSIS

This 20 minute program gives visitors a quick overview of some aspect of our area. This might be a short discussion on the geology of the area or of the Kokanee spawning in Fishhook Creek. These programs happen daily on our front porch.



## ALL-DAY HIKES

Okay, they're not really ALL day, but these hikes are a bit longer than our nature walks (roughly 4-5 hours). Follow a naturalist as you hike one of our beautiful trails in the area. Check at the Redfish Center to find out which trailhead to meet at. These hikes begin at 10:00 am and last until about 2:00 pm so pack your lunch, plenty of water, and your hiking boots!

## EVENING PROGRAMS

Evening Programs begin are held at the Redfish Amphitheater, Stanley Lake Overlook, or Wood River Amphitheater. At the Redfish and Wood River Amphitheaters, the fun begins with a campfire 15 minutes before the scheduled program. Come roast a marshmallow (provided by us) before you settle in for an engaging evening talk about wildlife, climbing, geology, history, or another Sawtooth National Recreation Area topic! Talks last up to 60 minutes.

## LADY OF THE LAKE BOAT TOURS

Lady of the Lake Boat Tours leave from the Redfish Lodge Marina on Saturdays at 3:30 pm and Sundays at 1:00 pm. Sign up at the Marina early! Pontoons take a 60 minute lake loop while interpretive specialists fill you in on some amazing facts and stories about the area! Boat tours are \$15.00 for adults and \$5.00 for children ages 6 – 12. Kids 5 and under are free. There is a \$60.00 minimum for the boat to leave so bring your friends!
