This map shows NON-WINTER TRAVEL opportunities and restrictions. Cross country wheeled motorized travel is prohibited on National Forest system lands except where designated. Contact local Forest Service offices for current recreation and travel information, and to obtain a Motor Vehicle Use Map with current motorized travel information.

Important Travel Notice
 Motorized, wheeled cross-country travel is prohibited on designated open road and trails. Cross-country travel by motorized, wheeled vehicles is prohibited on all lands administered by the Forest Service. Please stay on roads and trails.

Current local road, trail, and area restrictions still apply.
 The purpose of these restrictions is to protect riparian areas, wetlands, crucial wildlife habitat, threatened or endangered species, soils and vegetation, aquatic resources and/or to reduce user conflicts. Unless currently restricted, cross-country travel to a campsite within 300 feet of an open road or trail is permitted by the road district causing the least damage. Site selection must be completed by motorized means.

All motorized vehicle users should obtain the latest editions of Motor Vehicle Use Maps (MVUM) available for each ranger district of the Flathead National Forest and use in conjunction with the visitor use map.

The MVUM identifies and displays roads, trails, and areas designated as OPEN to public motor vehicle use. It is released annually as a free map available at all ranger district offices.

Motorized users must comply with the motorized use designations on the MVUM. Only those roads, trails, and areas designated as open on the MVUM are legally authorized for travel by motorized vehicles. Glacier View Ranger District has several designated cross-country areas. See MVUM map for details. Contact local Forest Service offices for additional information.

WARNING: Trail conditions vary according to a wide range of factors. Some trails are infrequently maintained. Hazards and varying degrees of difficulty exist. It is the user's responsibility to take necessary precautions to ensure their safety. Contact Ranger District Offices for up to date trail information.

DEFINITIONS

MOTORIZED: Road open seasonally to highway vehicles licensed under State law for general operation on all public roads, including national forest roads.

Highway Vehicles: Licensed for public roads, over 50" in width. Includes street legal vehicles, motorcycles, and OHVs/ATVs.

Trail Open to Motorcycles Only: These trails are open only to motorcycles, 2 wheeled, single track. Sidecars are not permitted.

Trail Open to Wheeled Vehicles 50" or Less in Width: These trails are open only to wheeled, motor vehicles less than 50 inches in width at the widest point on the vehicle.

Trail Vehicles: Typically not licensed or legal to operate on public roads, under 50" in width. Includes: OHVs/ATVs - 3 or 4 wheeled, double track; Motorcycles - 2 wheeled, single track; no sidecars

NONMOTORIZED: Motorized Vehicles - Any wheeled non-motorized device, includes bicycles, carts, wagons, wheelbarrows, etc.

AREA	CLOSURE INFORMATION
1 BIG MOUNTAIN SOUTH SLOPE	No bicycles on or off roads or trails, except on designated roads.
2 BIG MOUNTAIN HELL ROARING BASIN	No bicycles on or off roads or trails.
3 BIG MOUNTAIN NORTH SLOPE	No bicycles off roads. Bicycles allowed on Rd. 316.
