

Notice of Availability of  
Engineering Evaluation/  
Cost Analysis  
and Administrative Record**

Notice is hereby given that the Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) for the Blue Ledge Mine Site and the Administrative Record, upon which it is based, is available for public review and comment. The EE/CA was prepared pursuant to the Forest Service's authority under Section 104 of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) or Superfund; Title 42, United State Code, Section 9604 and Federal Executive Order 12580, and is consistent with the National Oil and Hazardous Substances Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP) as found at Title 40, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 300.

The EE/CA describes the Forest Service's preferred Removal Action alternative of removing contaminated materials located at the abandoned Blue Ledge Mine Site. The EE/CA and related documents for this response are located at the Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest Supervisor's Office, and are available for public inspection during regular business hours. The office is located at 3040 Bidle Road in Medford, Oregon. The documents may also be viewed at Siskiyou Mountains Ranger District, Star Ranger Station, 6941 Upper Applegate Road, Jacksonville, OR. Compact discs with the complete Administrative Record are available at both offices.
