



Wilderness Recommendations Proposed by the Forest Plan Revision

After thoughtfully weighing the factors of capability, availability, and need the Forest Service recommends what appears to be the highest and best use of the land.

This map shows four things. It shows which Inventoried Roadless Areas are proposed for recommending as wilderness (in peach) and which Inventoried Roadless Areas are not proposed (in lavender). You will notice that each Inventoried Roadless Area has its own name. Existing designated wilderness is shown in dark green, and the rest of the national forest is shown in light green. All other adjacent lands (public and private) are shown as white.

How these Areas will be Managed under the Proposed Revised Forest Plan
Areas recommended for wilderness are called *Preliminarily Administratively Recommended Wilderness* in the plan. They are managed to protect wilderness characteristics until such time as Congress acts. Existing uses (such as motorized recreation) that don't permanently alter the character of the area may be allowed to continue. Many of these areas are managed with this approach in the current forest plans. Also managed in the same manner is the Alpine Lakes *Wilderness Study Area* which was designated by Congress in 1998.

The Inventoried Roadless Areas that are not recommended for wilderness will still be managed as unroaded in order to preserve the ability of each area to offer high quality habitat, scenery, and a semi-primitive recreational setting. In the proposed action these are shown as *Backcountry* and *Backcountry Motorized*.
