At a previous restoration collaborative meeting there was a need identified to come up with a replacement for the old timber ten year order of entry approach in determining where to plan restoration and other forest management work on an ongoing basis. A FS team has developed a suggested approach which is based on the Watershed Condition Framework, Burn Prioritization Model, Minimum Roads Analysis, Timber Order of Entry, Forest Trails Strategy, USFWS Strategic Plan, and the Forest Restoration Collaborative focus areas. A team was convened to look at utilizing these different processes to determine where to accomplish restoration at a watershed level. Results of this work will be shared and feedback sought from the Restoration Collaborative Steering Team.
