BIGHORN NATIONAL FOREST ORDER
Occupancy and Use Restrictions

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C., § 551, and 36 C.F.R., § 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited at Hunter Trailhead and Campground and the National Forest System Road accessing the Hunter Trailhead as shown on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, together called the "Restricted Area", situated on the Powder River Ranger District, Johnson County, Wyoming. The purpose of this Order is to continue to provide recreational camping opportunities, while protecting the soil and water resources along National Forest System Road ("FR") 19, also known as the Hunter Creek Road, and at Hunter Trailhead and Campground.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. *Camping within ¼ mile of FR 19, in its entirety from the junction of US 16, FR 396 from its junction with FR 19 to its junction with FR 394 or within ¼ mile of Hunter Trailhead and Campground. [36CFR261.58(e)]*
2. *Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of posted signs in the Restricted Area, on FR 19 in its entirety from its junction with US 16, FR 396 from its junction with FR 19 to its junction with FR 394. [36CFR261.58(g)]*
3. *Hitching, tethering, restraining or hobbling of a horse or other saddle or pack animal in violation of posted instructions in the Restricted Area. [36CFR261.58(aa)]:*

Exemptions

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order;

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This Order shall be in effect from the date executed until midnight December 31, 2016, or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.

Violation of these prohibitions are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559 and 3571.
