**Forest Service Day Use Sites with Fees

The Following Day Use Sites Accept Northwest Forest Passes but not Golden Age, Access, or other Passes. A \$5.00 fee is charged without a NW Pass.

Buses and Large Vans Pay Additional Fees.

Day Use Sites which DON'T accept Northwest Forest Pass or Any Other Pass; A Day Use Fee is Charged. \$5.00 per vehicle is charged at Big Eddy, Clear Lake, Fish Creek, Frog Lake, Lost Creek (Lolo Pass area), Tollgate, and Trillium Lake. \$7.00 per vehicle is charged at Lost Lake & Kinnickinnick (Laurence Lake).

**What kind of pass do I need,
 and where do I get one?**

Buy your pass before driving out to the trailhead. Northwest Forest Passes are \$5.00 for a day pass and \$30 for a 12 month pass. Forest Service offices and over 20 vendors sell passes in the Mt. Hood and Portland area. For a list of pass sale locations, visit:
