

Region 2 Sensitive Species List

Fringed Myotis (*Myotis thysanodes*)

Recommendation Rationale: **R2 Sensitive Species**

Rare or patchy occurrences, easily disturbed, low productivity, limited roosting sites (cave, mines, bldgs). Maternity roost sites particularly vulnerable to disturbance. Two subspecies occur in R2: *thysanodes* and *pahasapensis* in the Black Hills. Since both are considered appropriate for inclusion on the Regional sensitive species list, we will list the entire species, *Myotis thysanodes*.
