Recommendations and Evaluations

Common Name: Cylindrical Papershell

Scientific Name: *Anodontooides ferussacianus*

Recommendation: Insufficient information available at this time

Recommendation Rationale:

Additional information was provided by the Arapaho-Roosevelt-Pawnee staff. In Cordiero's 1999 publication, he stated that, at one time, this was the most common of the three bivalve species in Colorado; however, none were very common. This species was reported only from the Platte River basin, and none of the current or historical records appear to be on NFS lands. Although the Colorado Division of Wildlife has done some surveys in eastern Colorado, the distribution of this species remains uncertain. We conclude that there is **insufficient information** at this time to determine the status of this species.
