

Region 2 Other Emphasis Species List

Bear Lodge Meadow Jumping Mouse (*Zapus hudsonius campestris*)

Recommendation Rationale: Not R2 Sensitive Species, But Should Be Considered For Other Emphasis Species Lists

This is a regional endemic of the Black Hills, found in riparian zones. However, we found no information indicating that populations are particularly vulnerable, or that there are known or projected declines in habitat or population trends. Therefore we conclude that it does not merit sensitive species status. However, because the subspecies is a riparian obligate that can be affected by FS actions, we recommend that it be considered for local management emphasis were appropriate by the BHNF.
