

**Not R2 SS, But Should Be Considered for other  
Emphasis Species Lists**

**Recommendations and Evaluations**

**Common Name:** Pallid Bat

**Scientific Name:** *Antrozous pallidus*

**Recommendation:** **Not R2 SS, be should be considered for other Emphasis Species Lists**

**Recommendation Rationale:**

Although it is sensitive to human disturbance, the taxon roosts in rocky outcroppings not commonly disturbed by people. Population trends are unknown, but habitat trends are stable. There is, however, some evidence of localized loss of suitable habitat and decline in range and abundance due to increasing human disturbance of roost sites. No concern in Colorado. Can reliably net them in western Colorado. Rocky habitats - not limiting. Should be treated as species of local management concern on those units and in those situations where recreation, oil and gas, or other activities adversely affect habitat function.
