

Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern

Recommendations and Evaluations

Common Name: Eastern Cottontail

Scientific Name: *Sylvilagus floridanus*

Recommendation: Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern

Recommendation Rationale:

An eastern species, Wyoming and Colorado are at the western periphery of its range. Appears to be common within suitable habitat in its range, including the National Grasslands. Urban and commercial development seem to be the only prominent threat and may increasingly be restricted to riparian habitat. Overall, NFS management is not of major significance to this species and threats appear few. Not recommended as sensitive.
