

## Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern

### Recommendations and Evaluations

**Common Name:** Plains Pocket Mouse

**Scientific Name:** *Perognathus flavescens*

**Recommendation:** Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern

### Recommendation Rationale:

Likely common, secure in Colorado, Nebraska and South Dakota. Range restricted in Wyoming to extreme Southeast corner of state, which leads to state ranking of imperiled. Although there is no concern for the viability of the Plains pocket mouse as a whole, populations of the subspecies *relictus*, an endemic of the San Luis Valley in Colorado, may be locally vulnerable because of their extremely limited distribution.
