- There is 1.35 miles of Specified Road Reconstruction and 1.18 miles of Prehaul Maintenance required by this Contract.
- No Road Maintenance Deposits will be charged for this contract.
- Payment Units 5 and 6 of the Oxbow Timber Sale are adjacent to Payment Units 11 and 13 of the Big Bass Timber Sale, and Payment Units 2 and 4 of the Oxbow Timber Sale are adjacent to Payment Units 2 and 16 of the Tilia Salvage Stewardship Timber Sale.
- Shared use and maintenance of FR3901-F2 will be required with the purchasers of the Big Bass Timber Sale and Tilia Salvage Stewardship Timber Sale.
- There are restrictions on the use of Snowmobile Trail #15 and the powerline clearing limits for harvest operations. Refer to CT 6.314# of the sample contract.
