The Forest Service will receive sealed bids in public at Cowlitz Valley Ranger District, 10024 U.S. Highway 12, Randle, WA 98377 at 10:00 AM local time on 09/12/2011 for an estimated volume of 4910 CCF of Douglas-fir sawtimber, and 3270 CCF of Western Hemlock and Other Coniferous Species sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting. In addition, there is within the sale area an estimated volume of 232 CCF of All Coniferous Species grn bio cv that the bidder agrees to remove at a fixed rate. This is a small business set-aside sale. If no self-certifying small business concern makes a valid bid, the Forest Service will readvertise this sale without restrictions on bidder size. Sale contains specified roads with an estimated public works construction cost of \$161,963.00. Bidders qualifying as small business concerns under the Small Business Act may, when submitting a bid, elect for the Forest Service to build permanent roads.
