

# Open roads, trails, and recreation sites within the Wallow Fire perimeter

## ROADS

### The White-Arrow System

Forest managers are dedicated to providing public access to areas within the Wallow Fire perimeter, but public *safety* always comes first. Forest managers have implemented the White Arrow System within the burn area to help visitors distinguish open roads from those that are closed.

Though crews continue to mitigate hazards, and forest managers are able to open more roads and recreation sites, *dangers are still abundant throughout the burn area*. **Each visitor is responsible for his or her own safety. Always Look Up, Look Down, Look Around.**

- Open roads within the fire perimeter are designated with white arrow signs at the beginning of the road and at least every 2 miles along the rest of the route.
- Any road signed with white arrows is considered open for travel - even if this list and the map have not been updated - unless the road is otherwise barricaded, gated, or signed as closed.
  - Conditions can change due to flooding; roads may be temporarily re-closed at any time.  
**Barricades, gates, and other closure indicators always supersede white arrows.**
  - Crews are currently installing gates on several roads throughout the burn area. There are not any current plans to close these roads; **new gates are being placed in case emergency situations warrant an immediate closure for public safety.**
- Any road without white arrows is closed to entry, except for fuelwood collectors and hunters with valid permits.
- With some exceptions for licensed game retrieval and permitted fuelwood collection, all parked vehicles must be within 30 feet of the open road, and must be in an area designated as open.

**The White Arrow system only applies to roads within the Wallow Fire perimeter**

### TRAILS

#### Currently Open

Saffell Canyon ATV Trail  
Murray Basin Trail System  
All trails accessing the Blue River Primitive Area along US 191, FR 567, and FR 281  
Any trail in a designated open area may be used; however most trails have not been mitigated for hazards. Use caution!

### RECREATION SITES

#### Currently Open

All developed recreation sites within the Wallow Fire perimeter are open except South Fork Campground, and all the developed recreation sites in East Fork and West Fork of the Black River
