

- ◆ Goal 1: Oversee planning, development, management and protection of the NPNHT with sensitivity to its historic and cultural significance.
 - A. Identify and promote opportunities for kids and adults, especially the Nez Perce people, to become actively involved in the stewardship and the management of the trail
 - B. Identify and develop partnership opportunities for trail stewardship
 - C. Complete the CMP revision plan
 - D. Assist in trail maintenance/construction/reconstruction
 - E. Monitor the status of congressionally designated areas and manage them to protect and enhance the values for which they were designated
 - F. Inventory, acquire and provide appropriate access to and through the trail
 - G. Reduce adverse impacts from invasive species

- ◆ Goal 2: To be the first and best source of information, reconnecting kids with nature and the history of the NPNHT.
 - A. Reprint brochures/maps
 - B. Develop video series w/education guides
 - C. Promote the NPNHT in communities and schools through resource stewardship and interpretive presentations
 - D. Develop state board certified educational/stewardship materials
 - E. Promote the NPNHT with collectable interpretive items (posters, postcards, activities books, etc.)
 - F. Design interactive web maps and virtual journey panorama web pages
 - G. Develop at least two partner initiated projects for “kids in the woods”

- ◆ Goal 3: To extend the route of the NPNHT to include the capture of Red Heart’s band, the exile history, the escape to Canada and the subsequent return to the north west.
 - A. Certify two sites along the route not currently designated as NPNHT
 - B. Ensure certified sites are clearly, accurately, and tastefully interpretive
 - C. Create a consistent GIS map layer for these routes
 - D. Assist and support initiatives for trail extension
 - E. Develop media to interpret the trail history
