On May 18, 2011, John Kiefer, Andy Habgood, Kendell Hughes, and I met with you and Quinn to discuss your 2011 Annual Operating Instructions (AOI) for the Railroad Allotment. At this meeting, we also reviewed and signed your Term Grazing Permit. This included a review of the Terms and Conditions (Parts 1, 2, and 3) of the Permit, range improvements, the Allotment Management Plan (AMP), and associated maps. I have included a signed copy of the Term Grazing Permit for the Railroad Allotment for your records.

At the end of October the 50 hd in the Fence pasture will be moved into the Capps Pasture.
