Recommendation Rationale					
<p>Regional endemic to se WY and n CO. Although restricted to s relatively small geographic area, this plant is locally abundant (250,000 individuals in WY and 6,000 in CO). Grows in wet meadows, streambanks, ditches and hay meadows with poorly drained soils. May be increasing in WY due to irrigation and may have declined in CO due to mining, water diversions, and degradation of habitat by cattle grazing. Herbicides could be a threat. Due to its limited distribution and potential threats to its habitat, we recommend this species be considered for other Emphasis Species lists.</p>
