Recommendation Rationale						
<p>We recommend this species be placed on Emphasis Species Lists for field units in CO and WY. We considered recommending not R2 SS and Not of Concern now for this species because it is apparently secure in NE parts of R2. However, its S1 rank in WY and S2 rank in CO suggests it should receive a closer look. We feel this species (or its dispersal agents) is limited to lower elevations – It has widespread range throughout northern two-thirds of US and south ½ of Canada. This species could be impacted by grazing, drainage and other agricultural development of wetland sites, weed invasion, and water pollution but it has demonstrated that it is an effective colonizer of disturbed sites. .</p>
