Recommendation Rationale					
<p>We recommend this species be placed on a local emphasis list for WY field units. Marsh Arrow-grass. is circumboreal and has a wide distribution outside of R2. Region 2 harbors a central portion of its distribution. This taxon is habitat limited in R2 (springs, fens and seepage areas often calcareous or alkaline). There are no documented downward trends, however, its habitat is threatened by hydrologic modification and invasive species. Bonnie Heidel states that it is not a palatable to livestock and that it may increase with grazing pressure like common arrow-grass. It was assigned an AB habitat vulnerability with a medium confidence rank. Only 14 records are documented on NFS lands in R2 in WY. There are no population census data to assess viability in WY. It is not tracked in Colorado or South Dakota.</p>
