Recommendation Rationale					
<p>Distribution is from B.C. and Alberta south to central CA and southern ID, with a disjunct population in the Sierra Madre Mountains of WY and adjacent northcentral CO. Known from at least 7 occurrences in WY, 6 of which are on the Medicine Bow NF, and 51 occurrences in CO (13 of the 51 are historical records). Found along streambanks and in spruce or lodgepole pine forests with thick duff. This plant may be impacted by management activities such as logging and road building, but appears to be sufficiently abundant that there does not appear to be a regional viability concern. However, because there is a concern for local impacts, this species should be considered for other emphasis species lists.</p>
