

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE ORDER**

**NOBLETT LAKE, AVA/CASSVILLE, WILLOW SPRINGS DISTRICT  
MARK TWAIN NATIONAL FOREST**

Under authority of the Act of Congress of June 4, 1897, as amended (16 USC 551) and pursuant to the Secretary of Agriculture's Regulations set forth at 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart B (36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b)). These restrictions are in addition to those enumerated in Code of Federal Regulations Title 36, Part 261, Subpart A, and become effective when signed and will remain in effect until rescinded. Noblett Lake said are described and designated on attached map.

**THE FOLLOWING ACTS OR OMISSIONS ARE PROHIBITED ON THE MARK TWAIN NATIONAL FOREST, AND ARE NECESSARY FOR PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND TO PROTECT NATIONAL FOREST PROPERTY.**

1. Entering Forest Road 857 from the gate located west of the Ridge Runner Trailhead to the Noblett Lake parking lot including the lake spillway (Douglas County). **(36 CFR 261.54b)**
2. Entering any area behind the red carsonite post located at the Noblett Lake shoreline or any portion of the lake bed (Douglas County). **(36 CFR 261.58b)**
3. Entering any portion of the pedestrian trail located between the Noblett Lake Pavilion and the Noblett Lake spillway that parallels the Noblett Lake shoreline (Douglas County). **(36 CFR 261.55a)**

**THIS ORDER SUPERCEDES AND RESCINDS FOREST ORDER NO. R9-05-11-10, SIGNED SEPTEMBER 1, 2011.**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit from the authorized Forest Service Officer specifically authorizing an otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force working in the performance of an official duty.

Violations of these Prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [16 USC § 551, 18 USC §§ 3559 and 3571]
