NM. In WY, this species is known to occur in the Fitzpatrick Wilderness of the Wind									
River Range, Shoshone NF. In WY, this perennial bunchgrass is found in an alpine									
meadow dominated by Geum rossii. The species evaluation provided no information on									
occurrences in states other than WY; comments from the Forests reported that it has been									
collected on the Fraser Experimental Forest. Threats are unknown, and additional									
information is needed to describe distribution and abundance of this species in CO. We									
conclude that there is not enough information available at this time to determine whether									
the species merits sensitive status.
