Siskiyou County Resource Advisory Committee to Meet September 19 at the Klamath National Forest Supervisor's Office

YREKA, CA,—The Siskiyou County Resource Advisory Committee (RAC) will meet on Monday, September 19, 2011, at the Klamath National Forest Supervisor's Office, 1312 Fairlane Road, Yreka. The meeting will begin at 4:00 p.m. and usually ends before 8:00 p.m. The public is invited to attend and provide comment.

The best access to the Forest Service conference room is through the back door of the building, located on Mill Street, where there is plenty of parking.

The RAC is federally sanctioned by the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture and was formed as a result of the Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act of 2000. The RAC is a local advisory committee that recommends projects to federal land managers which will benefit resources on public lands. The fifteen member group represents a cross section of county communities, industries, schools, environmentalists, and local government.

The agenda includes project updates and financial status, and a public comment period. The last date to submit applications for current funding was August 1st, 2011. No new project presentations will be heard at the September meeting. At this meeting, committee members intend to set 2012 funding priorities for the projects they have selected this year. This process will be open for the public to observe.
