

Sudden Oak Death Quarantine Restrictions

Help Stop the Quarantine Area from becoming larger:

To reduce the risk of spreading the pathogen associated with Sudden Oak Death disease....

NO HARVEST is ALLOWED inside the quarantine area within the Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest of any Special Forest Products with the exception of mushroom and bear grass harvesters.



Mushroom and bear grass harvesters shall remove any and all soil from products prior to moving off collection site

STOP THE SPREAD OF SUDDEN OAK DEATH

THIS AREA IS UNDER QUARANTINE

Federal Regulation 7 CFR 301.92

Plants in this area are infected with *Phytophthora ramorum*, the pathogen that causes Sudden Oak Death. This organism is killing tanoak in southwestern Curry County, Oregon. It kills tanoak, coast live oak, and California black oak throughout coastal California. *Phytophthora ramorum* also infects many other forest trees and shrubs including wild rhododendron, evergreen huckleberry, and Oregon myrtlewood.

WHILE HERE....

- Do not collect any plant material (including live plants, leaves, twigs, and wood).
- Do not collect soil and avoid muddy areas.
- Stay on established trails and respect trail closures.
- Park your vehicle in designated parking areas.

BEFORE GOING TO UNINFESTED AREAS....

- Clean soil and mud off of shoes, mountain bikes, and pet's paws.
- Wash mud or soil off tires, wheel wells and the undercarriage of your vehicle at the nearest automated car wash.
