**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on the National Forest System area and trails described in this Order, within the administrative and proclaimed boundaries of the Krassel Ranger District, Payette National Forest. This Order will be in effect when signed and remain in effect until further notice.

1. Going into or being upon the fire area (as described below). **36 CFR 261.53(e)**

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

**AREA DESCRIPTION**

**Burnt Knob Fire Area (including all trails within the described area)**- boundary is described as starting at Chamberlain trailhead located within Township 24 North, Range 10 East, Section 35 then continuing West along, but not including, trail #024 approximately 5 miles to the intersection of trail #017 located at Township 24 North, Range 9 East, Section 24, continuing Westerly approximately 5 miles to the Frank Church River of No Return Wilderness (FCRNRW) boundary at Lemhi Bar on the Main Salmon River, located at Township 25 North, Range 9 East, Section 32, then continuing Easterly along FCRNRW (Main Salmon River) approximately 12 miles to the intersection of Big Eddy Bar located at Township 26 North, Range 10 East, Section 28, continuing Southeasterly (leaving the Main Salmon River) along the Northern ridgeline of Hida Ridge to the intersection of Hida Creek located at Township 25 North, Range 10 East, Section 3, continuing South approximately 1.5 miles to the intersection of Magpie Creek and trail #029 located at Township 25 North, Range 10 East, Section 14. Boundary continuing South along, but not including, trail #029 approximately 4 miles to the

intersection of trail #025 located at Township 25 North, Range 10 East, Section 36, continuing Southwest along, but not including, trail #025 approximately 2.5 miles to the intersection of trail #001 located at Township 24 North, Range 10 East, Section 3, continuing South along, but not including, trail #001 approximately 4.5 miles to the Chamberlain Trailhead located at Township 24 North, Range 10 East, Section 35.


**PURPOSE**

The area and trails are closed for public health, safety and protection from hazards associated with wildfire and suppression efforts related to the Burnt Knob Fire within the Frank Church River of No Return Wilderness Area.

**IMPLEMENTATION**

1. This Order will be in effect when signed, and remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the above-described roads is attached to and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this order is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six months [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7), and/or appropriate State laws].
4. This Order supersedes any previous orders/notices for the above-described roads or portions thereof.


