

**FOREST ORDER**

**WILDFIRE CLOSURE**

**MT. HOOD NATIONAL FOREST  
Clackamas River Ranger Districts**

Pursuant to 36 CFR, 261.50(a) and 36 CFR 261(b) and effective immediately the following acts are prohibited until further notice, on the area defined in Attachment A of this order within the Mt. Hood National Forest, Marion and Clackamas Counties, Oregon.

This Forest Order is in effect until October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2011 or until rescinded.

- (1) Going into or being upon the area. 36 CFR 261.53(e)

Area description is defined by legal boundaries of the Bull of the Woods Wilderness.

- (2) Being on a closed trail 36 CFR 261.55 (a).

Trail closures affect all trails within the Bull of the Woods Wilderness including:

- Elk Creek Trail #559
- Mother Lode Trail #558
- Dickey-Creek Trail #553
- Bagby Trail #554 above the hot springs at the wilderness boundary
- Twin Lake Trail #573
- Pansy Lake Trail #551
- Bull of the Woods #550
- Welcome Lakes Trail #554
- Whetstone Trail #546 from Road 7020 to Bagby Tr. #544
- Battle Axe Mountain Trail #3340

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:


1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
