ORDER NO: UMP 276

PUBLIC USE RESTRICTIONS-FIRE

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the boundaries of the Umpqua National Forest, as described in this order and Appendix A, beginning September 8, 2011 at 0001 until further notice or unless sooner rescinded.

1. Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire, except in designated recreation sites, approved in Appendix A, in approved fire rings, fireplaces or stoves provided. Commercially produced pressurized liquid or gas stoves are permitted. Using charcoal briquette stoves is prohibited. [36 CFR 261.52(a)]
2. Possessing or using a motor vehicle, except on a forest development road which is constructed and maintained for automobile use and maintained clear of flammable debris. Camping with a recreational vehicle or camper is permitted within 300 feet of a forest development road. [36 CFR 261.56]
3. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site (listed in Appendix A), or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter that is cleared of all flammable material. [36 CFR 261.52(d)]
4. Operating an internal combustion engine other than a motor vehicle. Motors on watercraft, dredging within stream and the use of generators in designated recreation sites (listed in Appendix A) is permitted. [36 CFR 261.52(h)J]
5. Welding or operating an acetylene or other torch with open flame. [36 CFR 261.52(i)]

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local official, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
