FOREST ORDER UMP279

UMPQUA NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR Part 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited within the boundaries of the Umpqua National Forests as shown in Exhibit A – Area Map, to provide for public health and safety due to active fire in the area. The order is effective beginning September 12th, 2011 and ending on October 31, 2011, unless rescinded sooner.

1) Being on the road.

[36 CFR 261.54(e)]

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Any Federal, State, or local Officer of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 2) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.


This order will become effective immediately.

Violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than 6 months or both, Title 16, U.S.C., Section 551 and USC 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571.
