POSSESSING, STORING OR TRANSPORTING MARIJUANA

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b) the following acts are prohibited within the area, including roads and trails, as described in this Order and as depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, within the Cibola National Forest and Grasslands, in the states of New Mexico, Oklahoma and Texas.

1. Possessing, storing, or transporting marijuana – (*Cannibis sativa L.* as defined by 21 U.S.C. § 802.) 36 CFR § 261.58(t)

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.


RESTRICTED AREA

All areas, roads, and trails within the boundaries of the Cibola National Forest and Grasslands.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until rescinded or until August 31, 2013.
2. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581]
3. This Order supersedes, rescinds, and replaces any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by the Order.


