

# Sabine National Forest



Abstract: Roads analysis is an integrated ecological, social, and economic science based approach to transportation planning that addresses existing and future road management options. This roads analysis reviews the current state of the transportation system on the Sabine National Forest and focuses on the State, County, and Forest Service roads that are maintained for public use with passenger cars. Resource issues, budget concerns, and other local management problems were addressed in this analysis to make recommendations and identify opportunities to manage, maintain, and improve the forest roads system.
