Forest Supervisor's Order

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulation 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited as described below, within the Madison Ranger District on the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest. This temporary restriction is in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations and will remain in effect from September 15, 2011 through September 14, 2012 unless rescinded earlier. This order replaces order number 2011-D6-036.

36 CFR 261.55 – Forest Development Trails:

It is prohibited to "Use any type of vehicle prohibited by the order." [Title 36 CFR 261.55 (b)]

For the purpose of this order, Trail No. 8300 is closed to all motorized vehicles for public health and safety, water is overflowing the bridge making it unsafe for motor vehicles, from September 15, 2011 through September 14, 2012 unless rescinded earlier.

The closure area description follows with a map attachment.

Area Description:

Trail No. 8300 – Beginning in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, of Section 33, T3S, R4W; thence Northerly to the end of the road in Section 22, T3S, R4W.

Exemptions:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following are exempt from this restriction:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.


Penalty:

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571).
