<p>This horsetail is widespread outside of R2...circumboreal, including the Great Lake states, the northeast, the northwest and the northern portion of Utah. Within R2, it has been identified in one population in SD, 51 element occurrences in WY and limited records in CO. Habitat includes; wet sandy soils of riverbanks, beaches, ditches and meadows. This species is a wetland plant that may require soil disturbance for initial establishment. The general habitat aforementioned is not lacking in any state of R2.</p>
