<p>Known from CA and OR, east to MT, UT, NV, and AZ (G4). In R2, known from only a single occurrence on the Shoshone NF. Habitat is described as granitic cliffs and rocky slopes at 9,950-10,600 ft. Population trend is not known since it was last observed in 1985. Habitat trend is not known. Threats are probably low, although the site in WY receives heavy recreation use. There is insufficient information available to determine whether the species merits sensitive status.</p>
