***ROAD CLOSURE
NFSR #025LB (Kettle Cr. Road)
For Public Safety Due to Spring Runoff Damage***

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on the National Forest System road described in this order, within the administrative boundaries of the Lowman Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This Order will be in effect upon signing and will remain in effect until further notice:

1. Using a motorized vehicle on the road (as described below). **36 CFR 261.54(a)**

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this order is to provide for the protection of public health and safety, and to prevent additional resource damage to the road due to spring runoff damage.

ROAD CLOSURE DESCRIPTION

National Forest System Road (NFSR) #025LB – (aka. Kettle Cr. Road) is described as being within the Lowman Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Boise Meridian, Boise County, Idaho. The road is located approximately MP 83.5 Highway 21, and will be closed beginning at the gate up said road to its terminus.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be in effect upon signing and will remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the above-described area is attached to and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this order is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six months [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. This Order supersedes any previous orders/notices for the above-described roads or portions thereof.

Assessment of Need and Enforcement Plan
 Lowman Ranger District – Boise National Forest
 Order #0402-05-39

1. Background. NFSR #025LB had a major fill slope failure .5 miles off Highway 21 during the spring of 2011. The overall road width is less than 8 feet and is impassable to motorized vehicles. The closure is required for public safety and to protect the road from further resource damage and for reconstruction.

2. Intent of Subpart B order. This temporary road closure is for all motorized vehicles to promote public safety and prevent resource damage until the road can be repaired.

3. Enforcement Plan. On the ground signing and temporary barricades will be utilized to inform the public of the closure. On site FS administrative personnel will make compliance contacts as needed.


