FOREST ORDER

National Forest System Road Restriction

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited on the described National Forest System Road (NFSR) (the "Restricted Road"), located on the Salida Ranger District of the San Isabel National Forest in Fremont County, Colorado.

The Restricted Road is defined as NFSR 6 (a.k.a. Hayden Pass Road) located in T. 47 N., R. 10 E., Sections 12 and 13, New Mexico Principal Meridian, Fremont County, Colorado. The Restricted Road is shown on the attached map hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A. The order is necessary to provide short-term protection of public health and safety.

**PROHIBITIONS**

Being on the Restricted Road. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e).


**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any federal, state, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force, in the performance of an official duty;
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This order shall be in effect from October 7 through November 3, 2011.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for a legal entity other than an individual, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).
