One bough permit per person per year. Permit valid only for one day of harvest.  
Have this information sheet, your permit and identification in your possession during cutting and hauling.

Zigzag Ranger Station walk-up window is open during business hours. Please wear a mask and practice social distancing. Permits are also being issued by phone/mail at either District, please call at least 2 days prior to intended harvest date to allow for USPS delivery. Payment method is by card over the phone.

Noble Fir/mix	\$0.15/lb	134 lbs Minimum = \$20.10	500 lbs = \$75.00 maximum
Douglas-fir	\$0.05/lb	400 lbs = \$20.00 Minimum	500 lbs = \$25.00 maximum

**Cutting is allowed within road prisms and within 25 feet of the road.**

**No bough harvest in these areas:** Wilderness areas, active timber sales or plantations. Road 58 East of Little Crater Lake Campground, Skyline/42 Road, 2645 Road, 2618 road, Highway 224, Highway 26. No harvest within 300 feet of water or wet areas. No harvest within 100 feet of any trail, campground or administrative site. Do not block or move barricades or gates. Respect road closures for public safety.

Species compositions may be a mix of Noble Fir, Douglas-fir, Western White Pine, Hemlock, Western Red Cedar and Pacific Silver Fir. Noble Fir permit allows removal of Noble Fir boughs and boughs from other species. A Douglas-fir permit only authorizes Douglas-fir bough harvest.

Be prepared for winter. Tell someone where you are going and when you're expected back. Cell service may be unavailable. Carry tire chains, shovel and extra warm clothes. Forest roads are not maintained for winter travel. The Forest Service does not tow vehicles or sell gas. Check road conditions and closures.

**Harvest Method:**

- Boughs shall be removed from the bottom half of tree's total height, as measured from the base of the tree on uphill side.
- Removal of bough branches shall not exceed half of the total branch length. Boughs that are within 4.5 feet of ground, as measured from the uphill side of tree may be pruned to within 1 inch of the bole of the tree.
- Climbing trees is not permitted.
- Using power saws to remove boughs is not permitted.





**DIAGRAMS DEFINING THE ROAD PRISM**


