FOREST ORDER

Occupancy and Use Restrictions
O'Haver Lake Campground and Day Use Area

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551, and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited within the **O'Haver Lake Campground and Day Use Area**, which is hereby described as those National Forest System lands located in Section 12, T. 48 N., R. 7 E., New Mexico PM, Chaffee County, Colorado, as depicted on the map hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A. This order is needed to assure public health and safety while the restricted area undergoes a significant reconstruction project.

PROHIBITION:

1. Going into or being upon the **O'Haver Lake Campground and Day Use Area** during the following periods of time:

Date of signature of order through December 1, 2011

April 1, 2012, through December 1, 2012

April 1, 2013, through May 23, 2013


EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force, in the performance of an official duty.

This order will be in effect upon signature and continue through May 23, 2013, or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. § 3559 and 3571.
