



Christmas tree Cutting Requirements - 2012

Some of the major conditions and prohibitions are listed below. Complete cutting restrictions are shown on the Lassen Christmas Tree Cutting Map. Both of these are made a part of the Christmas tree permit and will be enforced when using this Shasta-Trinity National Forest permit to cut on the Lassen National Forest.


Conditions of Permit...

- Permittee must be present when tree is cut and removed
- Obtain a permit from a local District Forest Service Office.
- Permit must be signed by the permittee to be valid.
- Permit must be attached to the main stem between the limbs and sealed in such a way that it must be broken to be removed from the tree.
- Permit must remain on the tree and be visible at all times while in transit.
- Permit shall be in possession when harvesting and must be presented to any Peace or Forest Service Officer upon demand.
- Lassen NF Christmas tree Cutting Map is part of the permit. Permit and map must be in possession when cutting and transporting a Christmas tree.
- Permit sale is final – No refund.



PROHIBITED...

- See Restrictions on Lassen National Forest Christmas tree Cutting Map
- Cutting or removing any tree with a main stem exceeding 6 inches in diameter measured at ground level.



- Stump heights greater than 12 inches and any live branches remaining on the stump.
- Cutting a tree on private land.
