PROHIBITIONS

FOREST SUPERVISOR ORDER NO. 08-13-08-12-01

Units 29 and 75

Pursuant to 36 CFR Part 261.50(a) and (b), and for the protection of wildlife resources, the following acts are prohibited within the specified areas and at or during the specified times. The areas affected by this Order are shown on the attached map. The Order is effective from October 12, 2011 through October 12, 2016.

Harassing, harming, pursuing, hunting, shooting, wounding, killing, trapping, capturing, or collecting of both wild and pen-raised quail or attempting to engage in such conduct.
36 CFR 261.58(v)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- a. Person(s) conducting dog trials (e.g. the training of bird dogs) provided that no wild or pen-raised quail are harmed, hunted, shot, wounded, killed, trapped, captured, or collected.
- b. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- c. Any Federal, State, or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.


